What can you do?

#### As a Member:

- Model respect for the flag at public events, such as sporting events.
- Visit schools at the beginning of the year to give some basic facts about our flag, our National Anthem and when we stand and put our hands over our heart at parades and ball games.
- Publish flag etiquette tips in your newspaper and on social media.
- Volunteer for a local patriotic event.

#### As a Unit:

- Work with your Legion Post to increase respect for the flag in your community; invite the public to participate in a flag disposal ceremony.
- Teach proper handling, displaying and respect for the American flag, as well as our National Anthem and Pledge of Allegiance.
- Organize a patriotic holiday event or participate in local patriotic holiday events (i.e. march in a parade)
- Encourage Legion Family members to fly an American Flag at their home.

These are just a few ideas to promote Americanism in your Unit and Community.

Remember to support Veterans and Military families as their loved ones are deployed. Wear RED on Friday's to support those who are deployed.

Support the American Legion programs and work together as a Family encouraging membership by carrying a membership application for the entire American legion Family. Wear branded clothing of the American legion, American legion Family, Sons of the American Legion and the Legion Riders where applicable.
