

**The flag should be displayed on all days, especially on:**

- New Year's Day, Jan. 1
- Inauguration Day, Jan. 20
- Martin Luther King Jr.'s birthday, 3rd Monday in Jan.
- Lincoln's Birthday, Feb. 12
- Washington's Birthday, 3rd Monday in Feb.
- Easter Sunday (variable)
- Mother's Day, 2nd Sunday in May
- Armed Forces Day, 3rd Saturday in May
- Memorial Day, last Monday in May, (half-staff until noon)
- Flag Day, June 14
- Father's Day, 3rd Sunday in June
- Independence Day, July 4
- National Korean War Veterans Armistice Day, July 27
- Labor Day, 1st Monday in Sept.
- Constitution Day, Sept. 17
- Columbus Day, 2nd Monday in Oct.
- Navy Day, Oct. 27
- Veterans Day, Nov. 11
- Thanksgiving Day, 4th Thursday in Nov.
- Christmas Day, Dec. 25
- and such other days as may be proclaimed by the President of the United States
- the birthdays of States (date of admission)
- and on State holidays

**Half-Staff the Flag on these Days:**

- **May 15** — Peace Officers Memorial Day: half-staff from sunrise to sunset
- **Last Monday in May** — Memorial Day: the flag should be displayed at half-staff until noon
- **September 11** — Patriot Day: half-staff from sunrise to sunset
- **Sunday, usually of week in which October 9th falls** — Fire Prevention Week: half-staff from sunrise to sunset.
- **December 7** — National Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day: half-staff from sunrise to sunset
- Upon reliable information that the current or former President, current Vice-President, current or former Chief Justice, or current Speaker of the House has died
