American Legion Auxiliary Minnesota Girls State is an amazing week of learning focused on responsible citizenship and leadership. Girls State citizens are immersed in learning about the political process by electing officials for all levels of state government and actively running a mock government. The week is filled with many learning opportunities with time for fun and the formation of long-term friendships.

The 74<sup>th</sup> Annual Session of American Legion Auxiliary Minnesota Girls State will be held **June 14-20, 2020** at Bethel University in Arden Hills, MN.

American Legion Auxiliary Minnesota Girls State is a non-political, non-partisan, non-sectarian program sponsored completely by the American Legion Auxiliary. The staff for the week is women who voluntarily give a week of their time to work with the citizens who attend this event. Girls from all over the state participate in this interactive program to learn about and live the Minnesota state government with elections starting with the city, moving on to the county, and then on to the state level. This diverse group of young women learn about themselves and what they are capable of while learning about the American Legion Auxiliary.

Units are asked to make every effort to sponsor eligible young women to participate in the Girls State program. Units may sponsor more than one participant provided they live in Minnesota or attend a public, private, parochial, or home school in Minnesota. The local high school partnership and recommendations are valued so please contact them early. Please remember that it is the Unit's responsibility to choose the participant(s), not the local high school. Remember they do not have to be a member of the American Legion Auxiliary or be eligible to be a member, all Junior High School girls who have completed 11<sup>th</sup> grade who are interested in politics and government may apply.

The registration fee for American Legion Auxiliary Minnesota Girls State remains at \$300. The Unit selects and sponsors the participant although Units may seek financial support from outside the Auxiliary such as The American Legion, SAL, Lions, Rotary, businesses, or also charitable gambling funds can be accepted for ALA Girls State. **Reservations are due in the Department Office by March 31, 2020.** The name(s) of your participants and their alternate(s) are due to the Department Office no later than May 1, 2020. **No refunds will be issued** after reservations have been received. Reservation forms and qualification brochures will be included in a Unit Mailing and will be posted on the department website at <u>mnala.org</u>.

Many young women throughout the State of Minnesota would love to attend Girls State and are looking for sponsorship from an Auxiliary Unit. Please consider sponsoring a participant not from your own community. Send in a reservation and indicate that you would like that reservation to be filled by one of those individuals. Our ALA MN Girls State Committee will assist in finding a participant and inform your Unit of who was selected.

American Legion Auxiliary Minnesota Girls State can only be successful with the many volunteers who dedicate a week of their time to serve as counselors and support staff.
