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**DELEGATES**

Each organized group shall be represented by **two** delegates with **two** votes at the Department Junior Conference, **plus one** additional delegate for each fifteen members or major fraction thereof. (Standing Rules). Delegate strength is determined 30 days prior to Department Junior Conference.

**ONLY** Junior Members will be allowed to speak on the Conference floor. Senior members are advisors only. This is the **JUNIORS'** Conference. Juniors will be seated by District. One advisor per Unit may sit at the table during the session, if space permits. The District Junior Activities Chairman will be the Senior Advisor for her District if she is present.

**ENDORSEMENTS**

Endorsements for Department Officers shall be sent to the Department Secretary. The Department Secretary will send them to the District Junior Activities Chairmen, District Honorary Junior Presidents, Department Honorary Junior President and the Department Junior Activities Chairmen prior to the Department Junior Conference (Standing Rules). 2. Any Junior Officer must be classified as a Junior member the year she holds office.

## **CONTEST ENTRIES**

It is the responsibility of the District Junior Activities Chairman to see that all District entries are brought to the Department Conference. **Please take all entries home with you.**

### **Junior Scrapbook**

Award Criteria: To the Junior Unit with the best scrapbook on all around Junior Activities.

Award: 1<sup>st</sup> Place - \$10.00 cash award and certificate

2<sup>nd</sup> Place - \$5.00 cash award and certificate

The following is a set of rules for preparing the Junior Unit Scrapbooks for competition:

1. The scrapbook runs from District Conference to District Conference.
2. There is no particular size for the Junior scrapbook and such to be determined by each individual Unit. It should be within reasonable limits.
3. The American Legion Auxiliary emblem must appear on the cover of the scrapbook.
4. The first page of the scrapbook shall have the name, number and location of the Junior Unit and Junior membership total for the year.
5. List the names of officers and offices they hold on the second page. If the group is unorganized, list all Junior members in alphabetical order.
6. The preamble shall appear on the third page and the first and last verse of the Star Spangled Banner shall appear on the fourth page.
7. Each book shall be signed by the Junior Activities Chairman and the Junior or Juniors and their ages that made the scrapbook on the very last page.
8. The scrapbook including the cover must be made by Junior members.
9. The scrapbook shall be judged at the Department Conference by three Junior members and one senior member appointed by the Department Honorary Junior President at the Junior Conference.

Scrapbook to be judged on a 10 point system:

2 points conforming to the above rules

2 points neatness

2 points most complete Junior Auxiliary program

2 point originality

2 points aptness for application to the Honorary Department Junior President's and Senior President's theme.

Any scrapbook not conforming to these rules will not be judged in competition but will be on display.

### **Poppy Contests:**

- There is no limit to the number of entries per Unit for the contests
- Only one entry per Junior per contest
- All entries must include large, small or a combination of the poppies.
- All white tags must be removed from the poppies
- All entries must be at the Department Junior Contest by 9:00 a.m. on Saturday, April 14, 2018 for judging
- All entries must have an envelope attached with the contest name and class number on the envelope and the Junior's name, Unit number, location and District number on a card inside the envelope

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**Classes for each contest:**

- Class I: Ages 6 and under  
Class II: Ages 7 to 12  
Class III: Ages 13 to 18

**Awards:**

- 1<sup>st</sup> Place: \$10.00 cash award and certificate  
2<sup>nd</sup> Place: \$5.00 cash award and certificate

To the Junior member in each class with the best Poppy corsage or boutonniere using Honorary Department Junior President Courtney's theme: "Veterans allow colors in lives of our Juniors" using the Crayon. Entries are to be placed in a Ziploc bag with a corsage pin.

**2. Poppy Centerpiece Contest**

To the Junior member in each class with the best Poppy centerpiece using Honorary Department Junior President Courtney's theme: "Veterans allow colors in lives of our Juniors" using the Crayon..

**3. Poppy Jewelry/Accessories Contest**

To the Junior member in each class with the best Poppy jewelry or accessory using Honorary Department Junior President Courtney's theme: "Veterans allow colors in lives of our Juniors" using the Crayon.

**4. Poppy Memorial Day Wreath**

To the Junior member in each class with the best Poppy Memorial Day Wreath with the Poppy as the focus of the wreath.

**5. Poppy Junior Membership Recruitment Board**

To the Junior member in each class with the Poppy Junior Membership Recruitment Board using Honorary Department Junior President Courtney's theme: "Veterans allow colors in lives of our Juniors" using the Crayon.
