WHEREAS: The Minnesota members have followed our Mission Statement of 'Service not Self' in supporting the American Legion by providing support for our veterans, our military, and their families while shaping a positive future in an atmosphere of fellowship, patriotism, peace and security; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota has demonstrated a leading effort in growing the organization and participating at all levels.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TIM WALZ, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Sunday, November 10, 2019, as:
